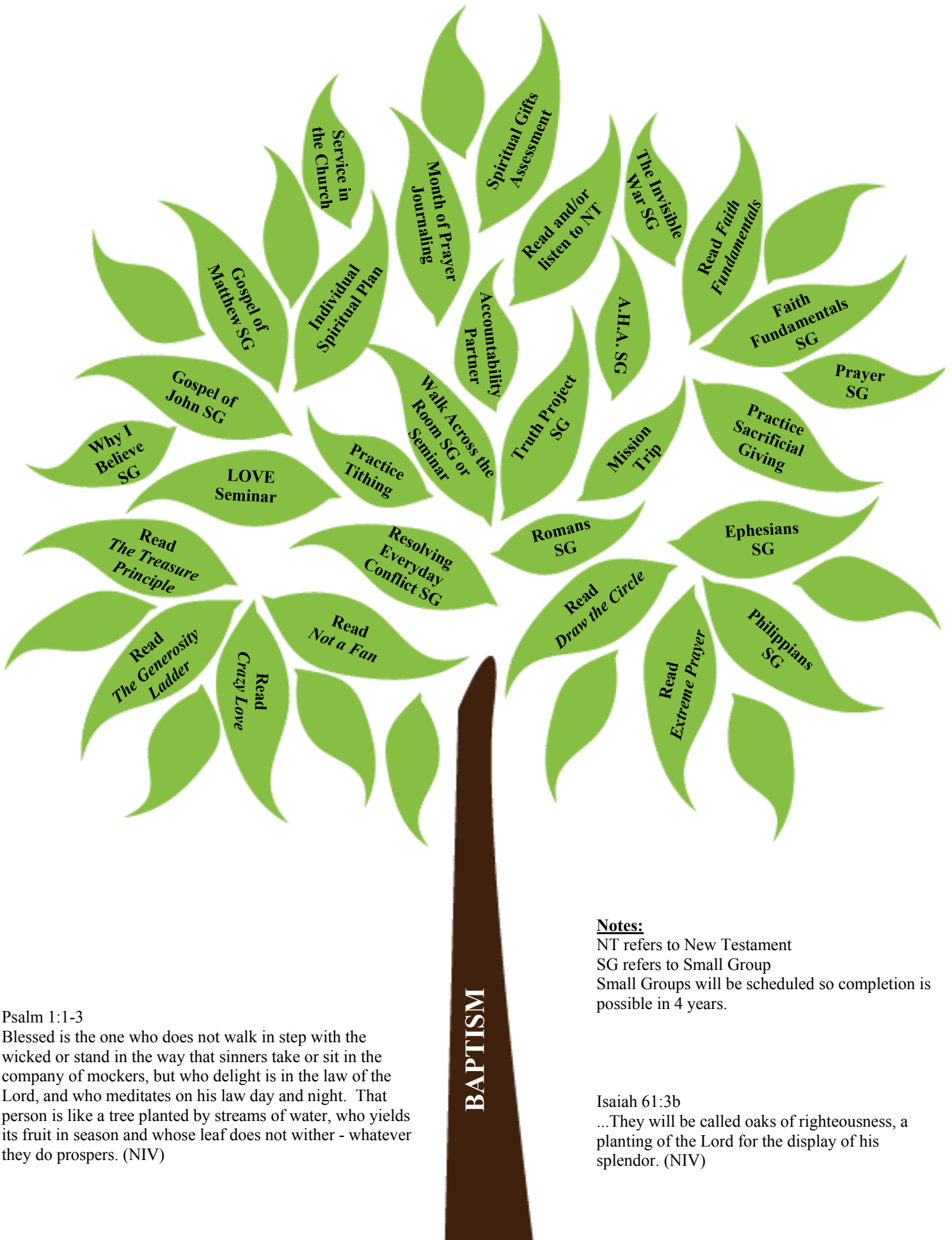


Growth Journey
